

UH-72 Product Office Transition to Sustainment

LHPdO has recently undergone a significant change of organizational structure due to the focus shifting from production and fielding to lifecycle sustainment support. Many of the tasks that were once the responsibility of the Program Executive Office Aviation (PEO AV) were transferred to Aviation and Missile Command (AMCOM).

The detailed breakdown of responsibility is complex, but generally all functions associated with logistics, sustainment, and training support for fielded aircraft (to include existing subcomponents and mission equipment) is now within the purview of AMCOM personnel. AMCOM is also in charge of overseeing the retrofit of new or improved aircraft subcomponents on existing fleet aircraft. LHPdO is now primarily responsible for functions related to designing and certifying new material solutions that will maximize the capability of the enduring Lakota fleet, configuration control, and Air Worthiness Releases. LHPdO will also head any future production requirements, should the need arise.
